The parade leaves the castle from Advance Gate at 2.00pm and turns into St Albans Street, then into Park Street, High Street (past the Parish Church and Windsor Guildhall), into Peascod Street then into Windsor Yards. The parade finishes in Windsor Yards behind the rear entrance of Daniels Department Store by the Jubilee Monument.
