The BBC Own It app is an online safety and well-being app for young people. It helps them keep track of how they're feeling, build online skills and access support for problems they might face online. It also includes a keyboard that responds to what they write. It might prompt users to think before sending a message or direct them to help if it thinks they're upset. The app is private and none of the data is shared with anybody else.

PopJam is an online platform and app aimed at 7-12 year olds. There's a focus on creativity. Users can create and share art, as well as taking quizzes. You can comment openly but there's no private chat and the app is only open between 6am and 11pm – users cannot interact with any content outside these hours.

Minecraft is a game that lets you build and create a virtual world using building blocks. Other activities include using the multiplayer function to explore the worlds created by other users and to combat, chat and play with them. Minecraft has a PEG age rating of 7+.




Honk

Omegle

Omegle is a free online chat site that lets you speak to other users without registering. You can choose to talk via text chat or video call. The service randomly pairs users in one-on-one chat sessions where they chat anonymously using the names "You" and "Stranger" meaning you have no control over who you can talk to.

Steam is an entertainment platform and app where you can play, discuss and create games. You can chat to other members of the community, through groups, clans or in-game chat features. Users can also livestream on Steam.

Twitter is a social media site and app that lets you post messages called tweets. These can be up to 280 characters long. As well as tweets, you can send private messages and post pictures and videos. You can also livestream on Twitter.

Viber is a free messaging app that lets you text, call, share photos and send video messages to people. There's an emphasis on privacy. The app has end-to-end encryption and you can also have Secret Chats; after your message is read it will automatically delete itself from your contact's phone.

Clash of Clans is a free cartoon-style strategy combat game played on mobile devices. You are set in a fantasy world where you build and take charge of a village. Players can build their own armies, known as clans, and battle other clans from around the world. You can battle clans on your own or join forces with other clans, known as Clan Wars. Although a free game, as with many other games it relies on in-game purchases to enhance the game play.

WeChat is one of the world's most popular social networks. It has multiple features, including text, audio and video chat, games and location sharing. WeChat also has a feature called time capsule, which, similar to Instagram stories, lets you share short videos for 24 hours.
